

On 6/9/2015 at 7pm Bob Rennard, N7WY, gave a GPS presentation.

Motion was approved.

Brian, N7BAM, gave the ARES report. Brian thanked everyone who responded to the activation of ARES for the flooding in Lusk.

Rodney, KC0ZHF, reported on the Technical Committee. Keys were needed for the repeater sites. Access to the .775 is limited and keys are with the City.

Section Manager Jack, N7MJ, reported on having a special event station for the 125th Anniversary of Wyoming Statehood. There will be a hamfest in Casper Labor Day weekend.

It was announced that Ron, WR8O, has resigned as Club Secretary. Those in attendance were asked to consider nominations for the position. A special election will take place next meeting.

NEW BUSINESS
